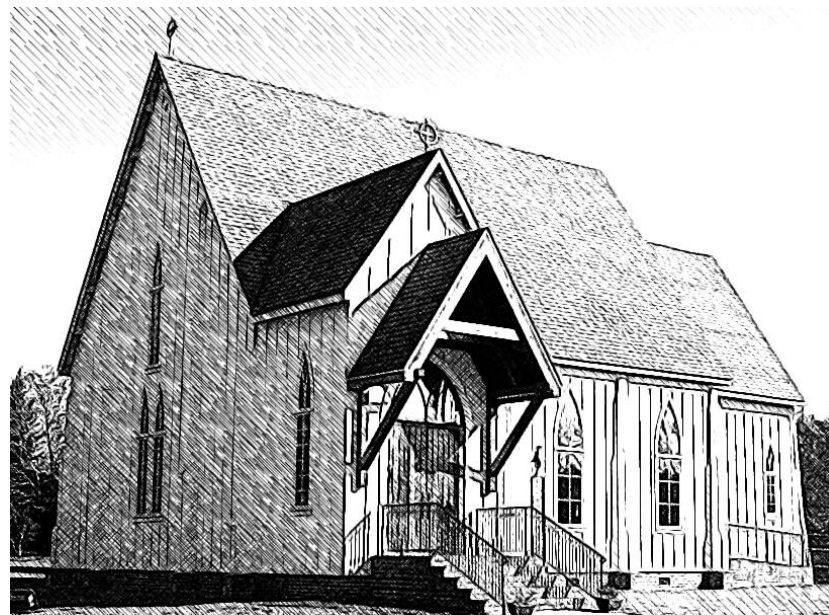
In Our Prayers

THE BURIAL OFFICE for Nancy Jones Sr. will be read at Christ Episcopal Church, 408 South First Street in Cordele, Georgia, on Easter Monday, March 28, 2016, at 11:00 am EST.

Mrs. Jones was a lifelong Episcopalian, devoted to the Church and the Sacraments. She was a steady supporter and advocate for Epiphany's Beans & Rice outreach program and a true joy to know. She died on Maundy Thursday morning at the age of 89.

She is survived by her daughter, Nancy Jones Dupree; and two sons, Dr. Ed Jones and Guy Jones, Jr.; and a host of grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
