*We sit for the Lessons and the Psalm, and the first part of the Passion Gospel.*

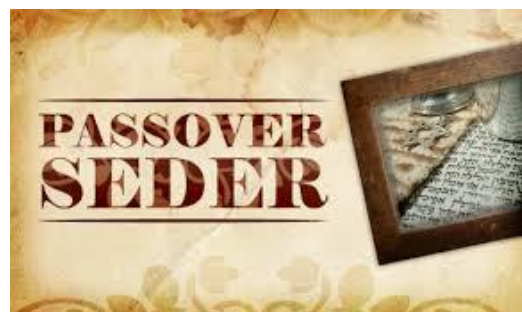
