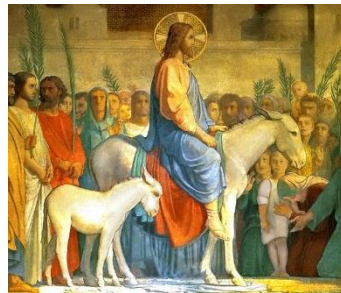

The Procession
