*Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.*

Your life is of infinite importance to God our Father. The Christian faith is unique among world religions in recognizing this essential truth. And not only do we believe that *your* life is of infinite importance to God, we believe that *every* life is sacred and holy to God—*each* person: Sofia, Alexandra, Juan Carlos, Monika, Maria, Augustin, Humberto, Magdalena, Marlen, Augie—and yes, most certainly, the life of Adriana Mercedes Latorre.

"A baby is born with a need to be loved," said **Adriana's** godmother, "and never outgrows it."

Not only do we believe that life is holy, we have undeniable proof. At the fullness of time, **God the Father** sent his only Son to be born of a human mother, to make this the way of life, that we might receive adoption as his children.

This, dear friends, is why we baptize all who come to us in the Name of the **Father**, and the **Son**, and of the **Holy Spirit**. It is not something we earn or deserve, it is a gift from **God**; it is an outward and visible sign of **God's** inward and spiritual grace.

And today, we have the gift of **God's** infinite grace and mercy in baptizing **Adriana Mercedes Latorre**.

We welcome her into the **H**ousehold of **G**od. **A**driana is sealed by the **H**oly Spirit in **B**aptism, and marked as **C**hrist's own forever.
